Water Crossings



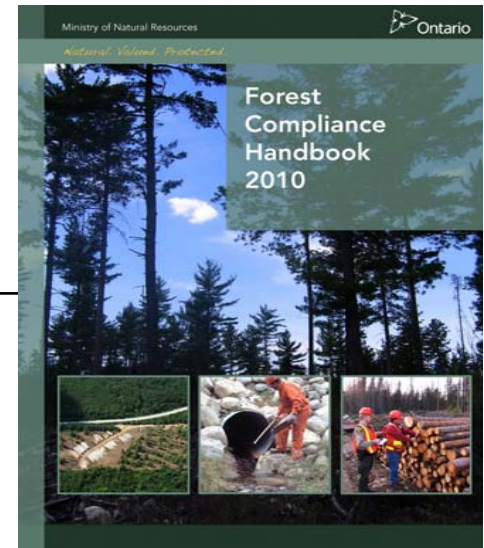
- Number of water crossings scheduled for new installations and replacements. Listed in AWS-1
- Six to be removed
 - Fulford#1
 - Broadsword #2
 - Robertson #1, #2, #3
 - Bawk North #1

Fire Prevention and Preparedness

- Industry responsible for fire prevention in and adjacent to operating blocks
- Follow *Forest Fires Prevention Act*
- Determine *Hazard Risk Rating* based on the *Modifying Industrial Operations Protocol*
- Implement appropriate measures



Monitoring



- Assessment of Regeneration Success
 - 14,900 ha
- Roads and Water Crossings
 - Roads actively used monitored twice/year
 - Roads not actively used monitored annually based on risk assessment, at least every three years
- Annual Compliance Plan
 - Priorities: meetings, hardwood utilization, site disturbance, water crossings, old Neenah inventory
